How to apply?

To apply, please complete the Membership Assistance application form which can be found online at www.abilitiescentre.org or at our Welcome Desk. Once completed, simply return the form along with your Notice of Assessment, paystub, or ODSP statement for the current or prior year or proof of income to the Abilities Centre Welcome Desk (Attention: Manager, Member Services). The MAP program operates on an annual basis, and you can re-apply once your membership has expired.

Once approved please provide a void cheque, credit card, or pay in full when signing up for your membership. All applicants who have been approved for membership assistance have four weeks to activate their membership.

Acceptance into the Membership Assistance Program is based on a two tier system of a 25% - 50% reduced membership rate depending on the amount of financial assistance required.

We encourage you to use your membership regularly! As a member of Abilities Centre, you and your family will have full access to our state of the art, world class facility, and we will be delighted to work with you to meet your needs and help you reach your goals!
